

Assistant Professor Position in Physics International Course, Osaka University

In Osaka University, we are going to establish Physics International Course (PIC) in Graduate School of Science as a part of Global 30 project supported by MEXT. In this course, we provide the graduate students with educational and research program all in English so that they can work as an active member of international collaborations, especially of large scale collaborations with large scale facilities. Osaka University is unique in that we have our own facilities as a high power laser and a high-energy accelerator. We are looking for an assistant professor who can contribute with faculties in Osaka University to the research and education program to realize this new course to be highly appreciated internationally.

Job Type: Full-time.

Contract: from start to March 31, 2012. This can be extended to March 31, 2014 after evaluation.

Qualification: Applicants must have a Ph. D. degree and strong research credentials demonstrated by published research.

Salary: Japanese academic salaries are comparable to European and American salaries and are paid on a full 12-month basis.

Deadline for Application: September 14, 2009

Expected Starting Date: November, 2009.

- (6) Two recommendation letters by reference persons. Information about the institution, title, name, telephone number, Fax number, and e-mail of the two reference persons should be listed in a sheet,
- (7) A statement of personal motivation for application to a position in Japan. (12 point, single space, A4 sheet, 1 page)
